# College Transfer Pathway - High School Freshman and Sophomore

#### Verify Eligibility:

- 1. Be identified as gifted by
  - a. Local AIG plan in English/reading and math, or
  - An aptitude and achievement test as evidenced by a score in the range between the 92nd percentile and the 99th percentile on the aptitude and the achievement test included in the current Mental Measurements Yearbook published by the Buros Institute of Mental Measurements, and
- Demonstrate college readiness in English, reading and mathematics on an approved assessment; (See Attachment A for college readiness scores), and
- Receive recommendation verifying the student has the maturity to enroll from high school principal or equivalent administrator; and receive recommendation of AIG
- Coordinator (if one is employed by the district), and
- Receive approval of college president or the college's chief student development
- administrator or the college's chief academic officer, and
- Receive written consent of the student's parent/guardian, and 7.
- Receive academic advising prior to enrollment in the program.

## High School Junior and Senior

### Verify Eligibility:

Student has an unweighted GPA of 2.8 or higher on high school courses or approved assessments in English, Reading, and Math **OR** 

Student has the recommendation of the high school principal or designee. Students who have high school principal recommendation may not enroll in a CTE pathway with a UGETC course.

## High School Freshman and Sophomore

Freshman or Sophomore may enroll in diploma(s) or certificate(s) programs in the following areas: Industrial Systems Technology, Business Administration, and Air Conditioning, Heating and Refrigeration Technology

#### **Verify Eligibility:**

- a. Passed Math I with a grade of C or better.
- b. Scored a 3, 4, or 5 on the EOC for Math I.
- c. Scored a 3, 4, or 5 on the 8<sup>th</sup> Grade ELA Assessment.
- d. Have the recommendation of the high school principal or designee
- e. Have the recommendation of the college's Chief Academic Officer or Chief Student Development Administrator
- f. Academic advising prior to enrollment is highly encouraged.

#### OR

- a. Have the recommendation of the high school principal or designee
- b. Have the recommendation of the college's Chief Academic Officer or Chief Student Development Administrator
- c. Demonstrate Readiness on Approved Assessments in English, Reading, and Math (see chart on page 1)
- d. Academic advising prior to enrollment is highly encouraged.
